DUTCHTOWN COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT ANNUAL REPORT July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019

I. Introduction

The 2018-2019 fiscal year was one of good momentum for the Dutchtown Community Improvement District (DTCID). After the initial creation and setup phase of the 2017-2018 fiscal year, the DTCID board was able to implement the strategic initiatives as outlined in the original petition approved by the property owners within its boundaries.

The DTCID has three primary committees — Safety & Security, Maintenance & Beautification, and Marketing & Development. Each committee is chaired by a DTCID board member and supported by local volunteers with an interest in the district.

Even though the DTCID is the largest community improvement district in the state of Missouri geographically, its budget is relatively small at approximately \$82,000 per year. The DTCID board has worked diligently this year to maximize the efficiency of these dollars and was also able to establish a capital improvement fund for the 2019-2020 fiscal year.

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IV. Services Provided

<u>Safety and Security.</u> After some initial setbacks in the 2017-2018 fiscal year finding an interested security firm for neighborhood patrols, the DTCID board signed an agreement with Campbell Security and Service Group, LLC on October 5, 2018. The agreement provides for security patrols by two (2) uniformed St. Louis City police officers for two (2) - four (4) hour shifts per week. This agreement has provided much-needed additional security coverage in the neighborhood. DTCID volunteers communicate regularly with representatives from Campbell Security, and all parties are actively working together for strategic scheduling and location assignment to address specific problems in the area as reported by our neighbors.

Maintenance and Beautification. In the Spring of 2019, the DTCID board worked with Alderman Shane Cohn and the City of St. Louis Board of Public Service to install new trash cans along the district boundary. The city agreed to fund the purchase and installation of the trash cans because the DTCID was able to implement a maintenance program by entering into an agreement with Metro Sweeping Service for weekly trash pickup and disposal.

Additionally, the DTCID engaged the services of St. Patrick's Center to utilize their workforce for cleanup and beautification work throughout the district. On a weekly basis, St. Patrick's Center provides staffing for approximately eight hours for various assignments, including trash pickup, general cleanup, and assisting with neighborhood plantings.

Marketing and Development. The marketing and development committee was tasked this year with sharing information about the newly implemented programs in the district. Door hangers were designed and printed for use by the patrol officers to let our neighbors know that they had stopped by while patrolling their area. For the cleanup crews, high visibility safety vests were designed and printed for their safety, as well as to inform neighbors that these crews were being funded by the DTCID.

DTCID also supported local neighborhood events, including the Go Dutch real estate event hosted by DT2 to promote home ownership in the area, and the First District Police Luncheon.

In April 2019, DTCID helped organize and promote a neighborhood cleanup day that garnered good participation from neighbors throughout the district and created a positive image for a "Clean Dutch" initiative.

An agreement was formalized with Dutchtownstl.org as the connector for the neighborhood organizations, and for continued promotion of local content and events through regular website and social media updates.

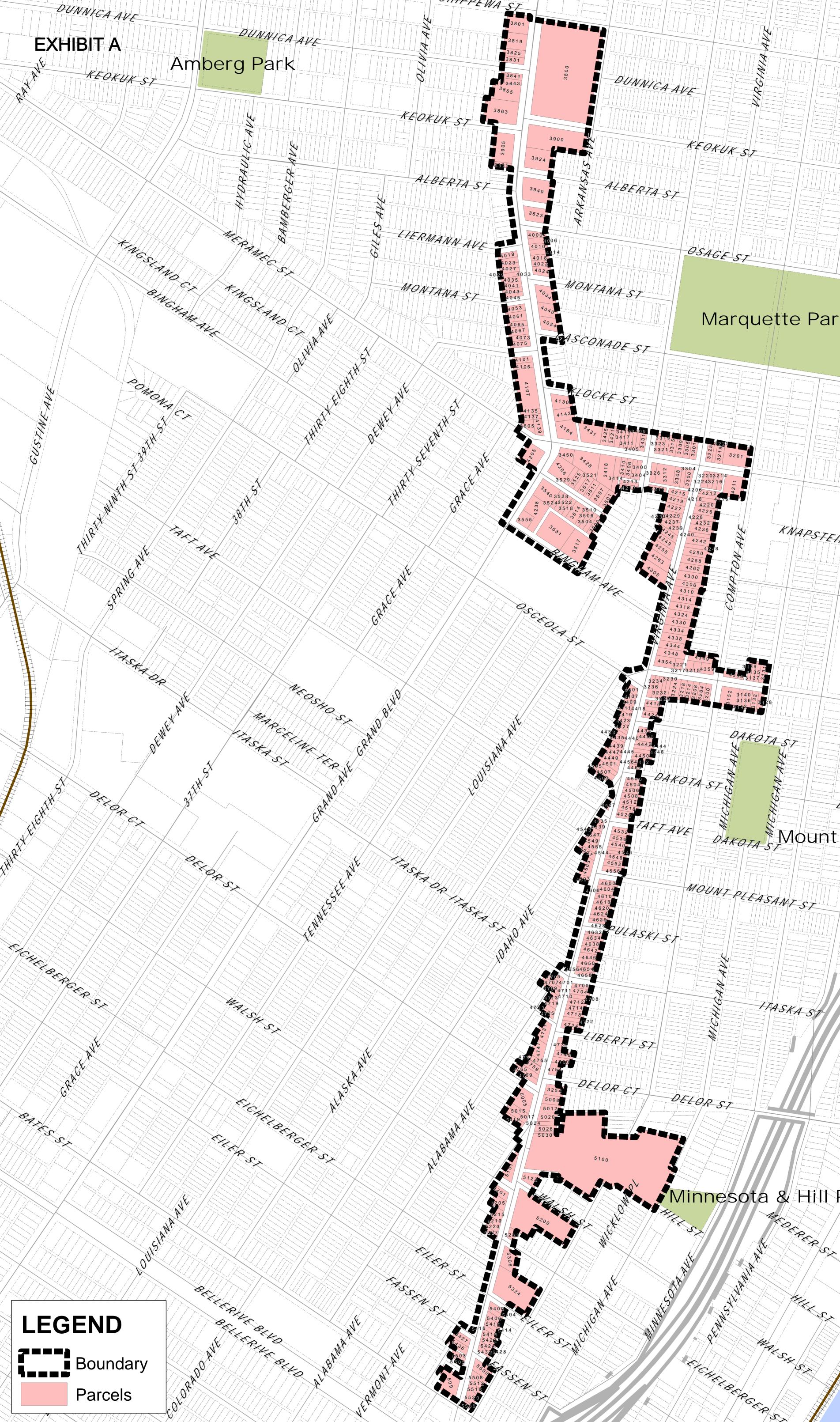
